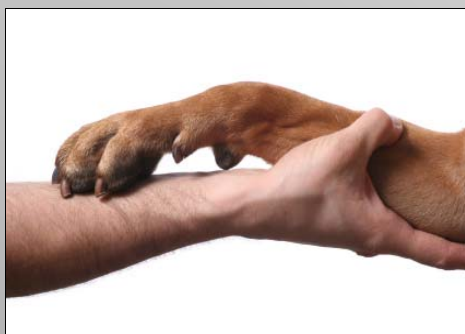

# Special Need—Fencing

As many of you know, Rescue K911 sits across seven acres of land. As of today, we are about 80% fenced in and enclosed. However, we do have an acre of land that is still open to the road and an incoming driveway that puts any of our dogs that are out and about in harms way. We urgently need this last little bit fenced in and secure gates to be installed so any of our dogs that get out of one fenced-in area can't make it further to the road. We have met with the fencing company and we need approx. \$6,500 for the fencing. If you would like to help us at all with this urgent project, we would appreciate it very much. # Our Cover Girl...Gigi

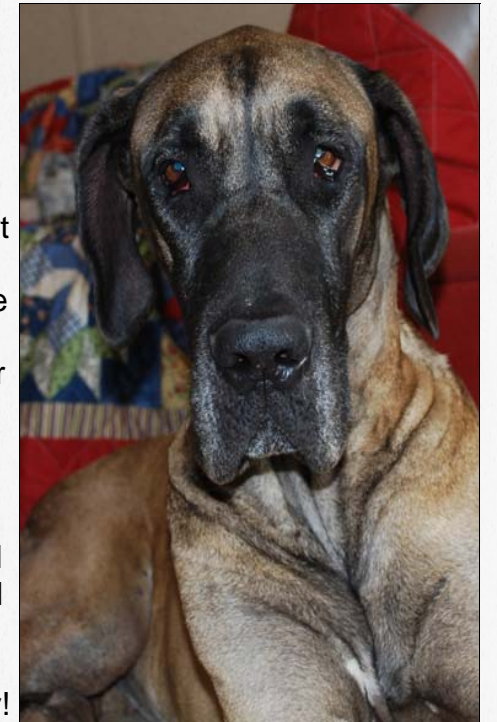

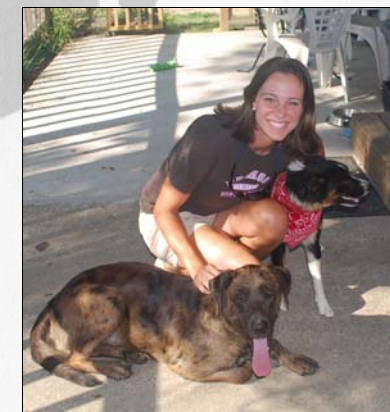


# “A Home of my very own!!!!”



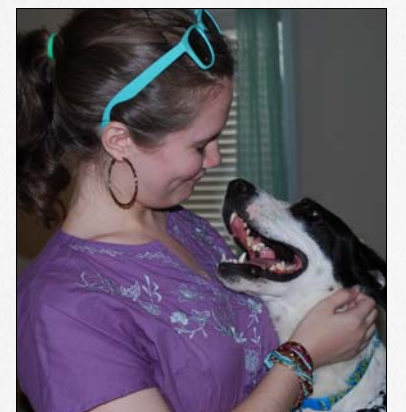
### Nilla

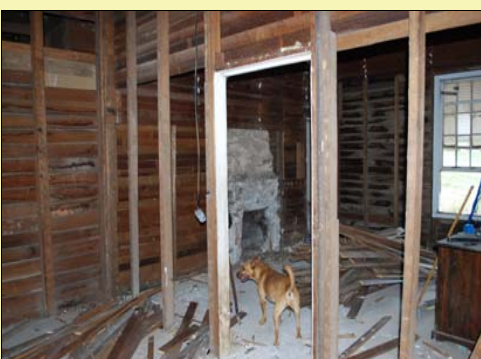


### JUNO

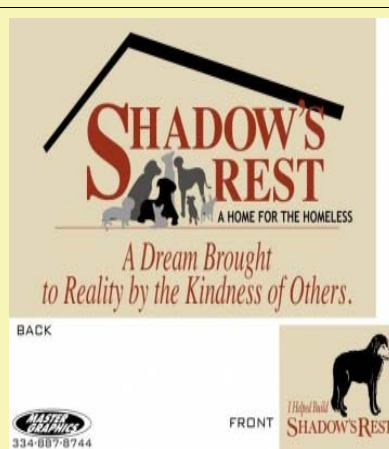
