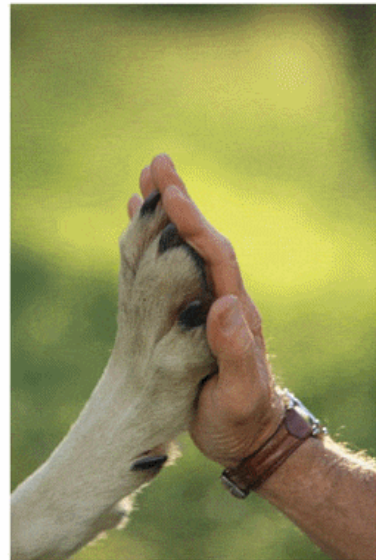
Dear Friends:

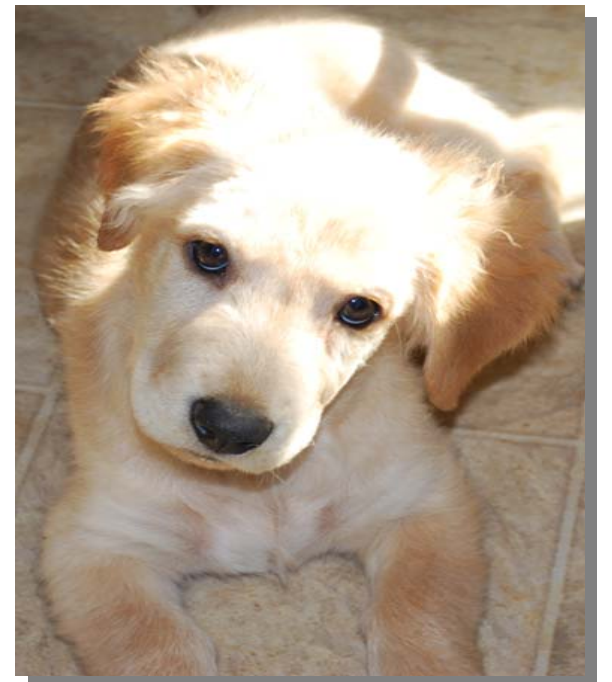

1. Donate

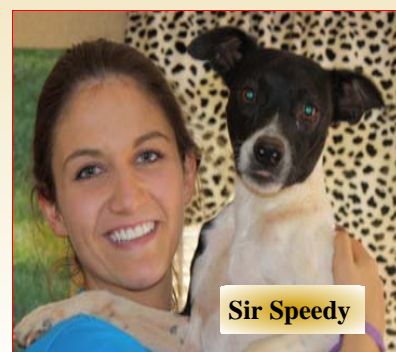

2. Volunteer

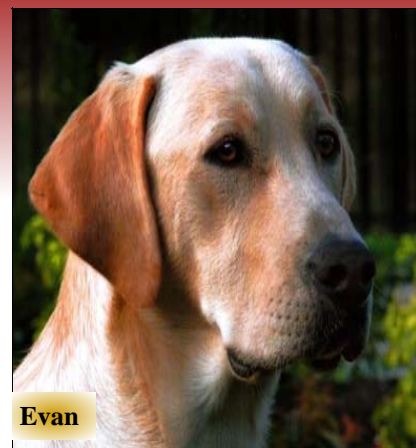
The holidays are a great time to volunteer! Helping hands are always needed to feed, water, or just spend some time petting puppies or walking dogs.

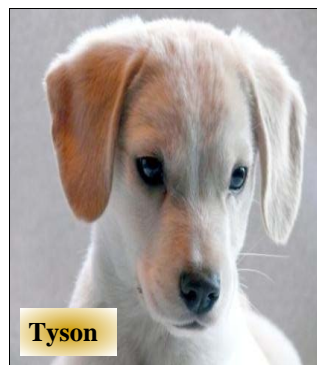

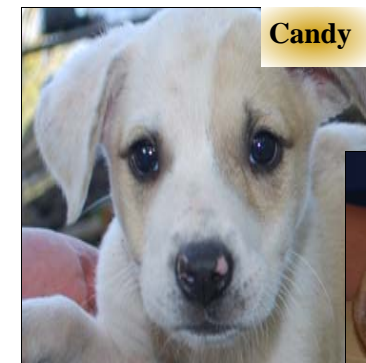

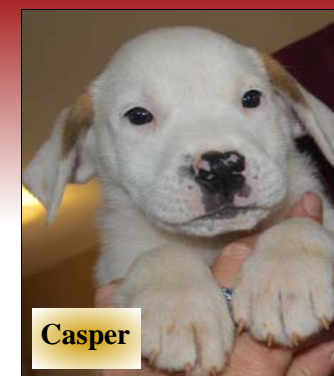
The Faces of Rescue

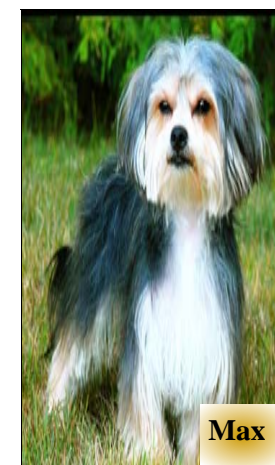

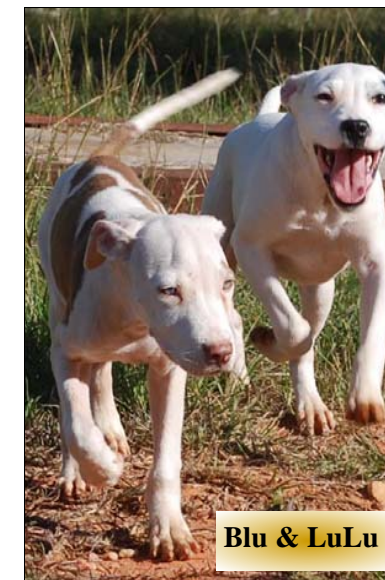

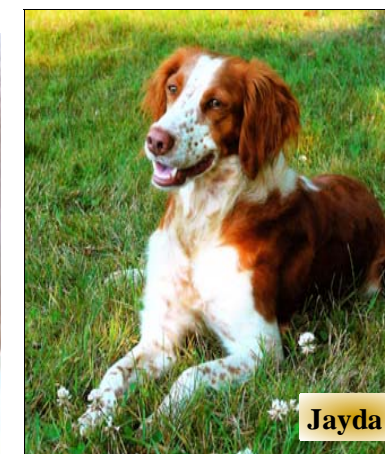
